- 3. Should your booking be cancelled, for whatever reason, every effort will be made to re-let the cottage. However we reserve the right to retain the balancing payment if it is not possible to re-let and recommend that you insure against cancellation.
- 4. All bookings are from 3:30 PM on the day of arrival until 10:30 AM on the day of departure.
- 5. Any damage or breakages in the cottage must be reported and paid for prior to departure.
- 6. Guests are asked to leave the cottage clean and tidy when vacating.
- 7. There is a no smoking policy inside the cottage and the studio.
- 8. Usually only one dog is allowed, subject to the guidelines below.
- 9. The proprietors are relieved of any liability for illness or accident occurring whilst guests are staying at the cottage. This includes loss or damage to property or vehicles.
- 10. Guests are free to use the outdoor pool, however they do so entirely at their own risk. No lifeguard is available and diving or jumping are strictly prohibited. The pool surround is slippery when wet and care should be taken to prevent falls. Children must be under constant supervision.
- 11. The proprietors reserve the right to decline accommodation requests.
- 12. The proprietors are entitled to reasonable access to the property.
- 13. To accept that, should the house become unavailable or unsuitable for letting subsequent to confirmed booking, through any cause, the owner's liability will be limited to the amount of any rental paid.

* Guidelines for bringing a dog to North Mundham House cottage and studio

You may bring a well behaved dog over 1 yr old to North Mundham House Cottage or Studio. We make an additional charge of £20 for short breaks and £40 per full week. If you are going to bring your dog you are asked to adhere to the following:

- 1. Dogs are not allowed in the bedrooms or on the sofas or any other soft furniture. Do bring with you sufficient towels and rugs to dry and clean your pet and to protect carpets etc. Dog hair gets everywhere so you will need to bring a comb and comb daily if your dog is hairy/moulting, and clean and vacuum thoroughly before you leave. Any damage, stains etc must be paid for in full.
- 2. Dogs may only be left on their own in the cottages if they are quiet and settled, and for short periods only.
- 3. Dogs are not allowed in the swimming pool.
- 4. Dogs that bark unduly, are aggressive to people or other animals, or cause a nucience or distress to other guests, are not welcome
